- **Tuesdays** are a day of *normal fasting* for Wayman AMEC from **5:00 AM to 5:00 PM**.

- **Why do we fast as a church on a weekly basis?**
 - We fast to change the direction of our world.
 - We fast because most of what we see and hear on the news has a spiritual root.
 - We fast because we want to sensitize our spirit to the Holy Spirit.
 - Below are scriptures that relate to prayer and fasting. We want to break chains and yokes in our lives and we want to hear from God.
 - **Isaiah 58:6-7 (NIV)** ⁶ *"Is not this the kind of fasting I have chosen: to loose the chains of injustice and untie the cords of the yoke, to set the oppressed free and break every yoke? ⁷ Is it not to share your food with the hungry and to provide the poor wanderer with shelter-- when you see the naked, to clothe him, and not to turn away from your own flesh and blood?*
 - **2 Chronicles 7:14 (NIV)** ¹⁴ *if my people, who are called by my name, will humble themselves and pray and seek my face and turn from their wicked ways, then will I hear from heaven and will forgive their sin and will heal their land.*
 - **Mark 9:29 (NKJV)** ²⁹ *So He said to them, "This kind can come out by nothing but prayer and fasting."*
 - A **Normal Fast** means to abstain from all forms of food, but not from water or liquids.
 - **Pray** for increase spiritually, financially, and numerically that the Lord of the harvest would send laborers to this vineyard.
 - **Pray** for wisdom for those in leadership.
 - Fasting is a **Spiritual Tune-Up**.
 - We **Sensitize Our Spirit** to the **Holy Spirit**.
