The McLean County Health Department (MCHD) maintains a "Dose Saver" waiting list, and we'd like to expand it. In order to avoid unclaimed, open doses of the COVID-19 vaccine during our daily clinics, we maintain this list to identify individuals who may be called on short notice. We are looking for individuals who, in most cases, can be quickly scheduled for that open dose and arrive at the clinic within a given time frame.
